RULES AND CONDITIONS

AQHA rules apply to all Burpengary Western Performance Club Inc (BWPC) events and shows

BWPC Inc take no responsibility whatsoever for any loss damage or left to any person/horse vehicle or property whilst attending our shows or events All competitors compete at their own risks

BEGINNER: Is a Rider who has won no more than 5 wins with 1 or more horses. Horses can be ridden in a snaffle bit or a curb bit (two handed). Beginners may not compete in open or novice or amateur classes. **BEGINNER Youth** must wear an approved helmet with harness strap and are not permitted to compete on 2 or 3-year-old horses. Youth cannot handle or compete with a stallion or colt Stallions may not compete in Beginner Classes

IMPROVER is a rider that has progressed from Beginners any queries contact BWPC Committee

OPEN is a rider that has progressed from Improvers any queries contact BWPC Committee

ALL Select, Master, Novice Youth and Novice Amateur Classes and Amateur: Must hold AQHA or other breed society relevant Card.

Ranch Riding horses are not permitted to compete in any Western Pleasure classes and Pleasure horse cannot compete in Ranch Riding at same show and horses must be 3 years and over to compete in Ranch riding

Classes marked with * are not point scoring classes for AQHA members

Judges decision is final any protest must go through the AQHA rulings

Back numbers will be allocated to each rider horse combination and must be correctly displayed when competing no back number or incorrect back number means NO PLACING

To qualify for **Members Buckle Series** you must be a member of BWPC Inc, you must compete in a min of 5 show out of the 7 in the series with the same horse/rider combination. Riders cannot change horses during the series.

MEMBERS ONLY HIGH POINT VERSATILITY BUCKLE SERIES*** COMPETITORS MUST COMPETE IN ALL CLUB MEMBER CLASSES AT 5 OF THE 7 SHOWS CLASSES INCLUDE AS MANY AS COMPETITOR WISHES TO COMPETE IN BUT OBVIOUSLY THE MORE CLASSES THE MORE POINTS.

NOTES FOR BUCKLE SERIES **ALL POINTS ARE FOR SAME HORSE RIDER COMBINATION** FOR OVER ALL HIGH POINT BUCKLES THE CLASSES ARE COUNTED AS DETAILED I.E. JUNIOR HORSE WILL BE OVERALL HIGH POINT HORSE RIDER COMBINATION FOR ALL **JUNIOR HORSE** CLASSES IN PROGRAM ABOVE, OPEN BUCKLE IS OVERALL HIGH POINT COMBINATION FOR ALL OUR OPEN CLASSES; **SELECT AMATEUR** WILL BE OVERALL HIGH POINT COMBINATION FOR ALL **SELECT AMATEUR** CLASSES ABOVE SO THIS RULE APPLIES TO ALL BUCKLES

OVERALL HIGHPOINT JUNIOR OR ADULT REINER WILL BE THE YOUTH AND ADULT HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION WITH OVERALL HIGHPOINTS IN ANY ONE LEVEL SO THAT WILL APPLY TO ANY JUNIOR OR ADULT RIDER. RIDER MUST COMPETE IN SAME LEVEL DURING THE MEMBERS BUCKLES SERIES

EACH RIDER IS ENTITLED TO ONE POINT IN EACH CLASS YOU COMPETE UNLESS DQ'D, SO 10 COMPETITORS IN CLASS & NO DISQUALIFIED COMPETITORS 1ST GETS 10 POINTS LAST GETS 1 POINT.

No illegal equipment or training aids permitted in marshaling area or arena within 1 hour of show or 1 hour after show. Any unaccompanied Youth must have the correct AQHA form filled out prior to the event. Dress regulations of Cap/Hat, long style pants, safe enclosed footwear and a shirt with sleeves must be worn if entering the ring. Amateur/ Select Amateur cards must be shown when nominating. All halter horses must be registered with their appropriate association and a copy need to be provided to the show secretary either before the show or on the day before the show starts. A copy of rego papers will be held for any shows after the first one. All performance horses MUST be registered with their appropriate associations. ALL DOGS must be on leash and controlled by owners AT ALL TIMES. Exhibitors shall not approach the judge for any reason prior to completion of the judging, unless the exhibitor has finished exhibiting and the request will be made through the ring steward or gate marshal only. Competitor's/participants at any event run by BWPC Inc. have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of the BWPC Inc. and the AQHA at all times. Competitors/participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated. No alcohol is allowed in, or can be consumed in the marshaling areas, working arenas or show pen/contest areas. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contest, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event. at our events: Please note that we might have an official person taking photos and /or videos that will be released on our Clubs website and/or facebook page, they are not for personal use.
