## **Now our 2019 – 2020 High Points and our upcoming Events**

With the change of rule applied by the Aqha we have tried to solve the situation as best we could for ALL members and hence offer the following

2019 – 2020 HP are cancelled because of the Covid-19 restrictions. We had to cancel our Mar, April and June shows so financially this decision is the best for the club

Then to reopen our club and recommence events and shows, we found that as an All Breeds Club and also an Affiliate of AQHA, we were so restricted by the change of End of Year dates rule applied by The Aqha. If we run AQHA approved shows than only AQHA Members would receive Association Points and if we run unapproved Aqha members would not receive association but PHAA and AAA members would. We found either way unfair to all members, so we have come up with our solution.

From August to end Oct we will run “Return to Play” and “The Challenge” Members High Point series. This will consist of 3 club shows including Western shows with The Challenge Classes added, Western Dressage Competitions and Ranch Versatility shows and we will award High Points and Challenge Buckles at the end of Oct 2020. These shows will be **fun** and **inexpensive** to help you ease back into showing. They will be capped so that all can enjoy and have fun without spending a fortune. They are club shows so just fun showing.

We will also offer some free clinics to help get started so look forward to returning to the club.

We have a full program of learning fun and showing and will then commence our 2021 show season from November 1 with our first A shows to commence mid November 2020.

## **RULES FOR RIDING WITH US FROM JUNE 13<sup>TH</sup> 2020 UNDER COVID RESTRICTIONS AS INSTRUCTED BY AQHA UNDER GUIDANCE WITH AUST INSTITUTE OF SPORT**

- 1. Number of People only** 20 persons to be on the grounds at all times. THIS INCLUDES co-ordinator, trainers, spectators partners or children so we ask that, as we are limited please contact us if you need to have someone with you whilst attending the event or clinic
- 2. Travel restrictions** within your state must be taken into account so as not to encourage people to break restrictions. So Only Queenslanders can Attend at this stage
- 3. Health & Safety Officer – will be appointed and is responsible for the following:**
  - a) All equipment etc. to be used will need to be sanitised prior to use
  - b) Public health records will be kept so name, address and phone number provided and the list kept for future reference if required by Government
  - c) All persons on the ground to keep the minimum of 1.5 metres distancing at all times
  - d) Parking of vehicles – allow reasonable distance between each parked vehicle
  - e) Using stables/yards – keep one stable/yard between each horse
  - f) Supply hand sanitiser at the entrance of all amenities (arena, stable/yard block, toilet facilities etc.)
  - g) Supply a leaflet to all persons in attendance that details the hygiene required to be taking part in this gathering
  - h) To make sure that if a person who turns up for this gathering is unwell that they are asked to leave immediately
  - i) All persons on the ground in attendance must be a member of the AQHA or the Affiliate holding this event
- 4.** All people at the gathering must complete a sanitising protocol prior to leaving the grounds – including the sanitising of their equipment/tack, this is for the safety of this person, family and other persons that they will come in contact with after this gathering.

**1. ONLY OPEN TO 10 PEOPLE IN WHOLE GROUNDS AT ANY ONE TIME**

THIS INCLUDES PEOPLE FEEDING HORSES, MAINTANENCE PEOPLE, RIDERS AND SPECTATORS. WE ASK THAT YOU LIMIT SPECTATORS OR ACCOMPING PEOPLE TO 1 AND ONLY IF REALLY NEEDED. IF 10 ON GROUNDS PLEASE LEAVE AND WAIT AT FRONT GATE TILL SOMEONE LEAVES

**2. FOLLOW STRICT HYGIENE AND PERSONAL DISTANCING RULES AS SET BY QLD GOVERNMENT & THE BWPC**

WASHING YOUR HANDS WITH WATER AND SOAP AT ALL TIMES IS RECOMMENDED, SANITIZER AND DISINFECTANT SPRAYS WILL ALSO BE PROVIDED FOR YOUR USE PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU USE THESE . NOT TO SHARE ANY EQUIPMENT OR TACK DO NOT SHARE DRINK BOTTLES SPRAY SURFACES

**3. TO ENTER THE GROUNDS YOU MUST BOOK INTO THE CENTRES BOOKING CALENDER AND YOU MAY USE THE FOLLOWING FACILITIES**

- A. OUTDOOR ARENA LIMITED TO 4 RIDERS AT ANY ONE TIME FOR 1 HOUR RIDES
- B. OUTDOOR GRASS & TRAIL AREAS RIDER 1.5 METERS APART ALLOWING 4SQ METER PER RIDER
- C. WASH BAYS ALLOW ONE WASH BAY BETWEEN YOU AND OTHER USER
- D. INDOOR ARENA LIMITED TO 4 RIDERS IS A SEPARATE BOOKING TO CENTRE BOOKING YOU MUST BOOK THE 2 CALENDERS TO USE I.E. TO USE INDOOR YOU MUST 1. BOOK TO COME INTO CENTRE ON CALENDER 1 AND THEN 2. BOOK TO USE INDOOR ARENA ON INDOOR CALENDER
